In the first four to six weeks of life, regardless of whether your infant is breastfed or formula-fed, you should expect your newborn to poop after nearly every feeding, Swanson says. It may be a "tiny smear" or have more volume, Cilenti adds. Does baby poop change with age? Baby poop changes predictably with age, reflecting diet, digestion, and health at every stage of infancy and toddlerhood. Baby poop is more than just a diaper change inconvenience. It's a window into your little one's health and development. From the moment newborns enter the world, their bowel movements evolve dramatically. What color is baby poop? For formula-fed babies, poop is often darker in color due to the formula's iron content. The color can range from yellow to greenish-brown or tan. It's usually thicker and firmer than breastfed baby poop and may be the consistency of hummus, toothpaste or peanut butter. How long does a baby go without pooping? Suffice it to say, it depends on what baby eats and how old they are. Usually he goes a day or two without pooping and then it's like 6 to 7 poops over 12 to 24 hours.
